



SAFINA's PRECIOUS METAL SHIPPING RECOMMENDATION

(packing and sealing)

General packaging guidelines:

Please ensure that the package is sufficiently secure to prevent potential damage or loss:

- Start by getting a box that is strong enough to resist the weight of your shipment and withstand any friction, pressure, collision while being shipped to SAFINA, a.s.. Gold bearing materials should be packed in wood, plastic, carbon-fibre boxes or secure closure of containers.
- Strong tape or security plastic seal is highly recommended to properly seal your shipment. Seals with a unique reference number are the most widely used security device for their strength, identification and traceability. It is easy to check if seal number on the transport documents is identical to the seal number on the container. If this number is different, the SAFINA, a.s. can immediately notify You without any delay.
- Packaging should be marked with the packed weight and with contact information including name, address, phone and e-mail.
- SAFINA, a.s. also recommends not to ship Precious Metals on Friday because the package will be left on a shelf at the shipper, leaving it open to theft. It is also crucial to use reputable services for shipping.

Pack your material securely so that the things contained:

- Cannot cause a harm to human health or safety,
- Cannot cause unpleasant sensations,
- Cannot cause damage to other items or equipment

Properly packaging of your Precious metals is essential to avoid any risk and to reduces the chance it will be lost or damaged during the shipments due to poor packaging.
